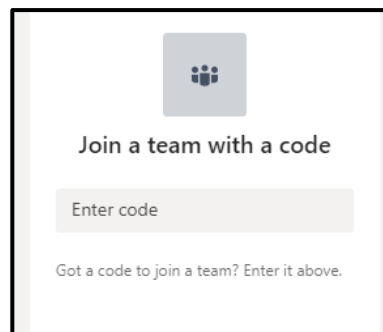
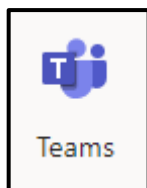

Mobile Crisis SERVICES

For children, adolescents and young adults in Orange, Osceola & Seminole Counties, Florida

When someone is in crisis, sometimes all he or she needs is a quick intervention to restore calm.

Mobile Crisis Services are available to anyone ages 0 - 24 located in Orange, Osceola or Seminole County at the time of crisis. Master level and licensed therapists will respond to homes, schools or anywhere within the tri-county community, within 60 minutes to provide immediate on-site crisis stabilization. Crisis therapists also connect families to the services and supports they need for long-term recovery.

Someone needing crisis services might be:

- Out-of-control emotionally
- Threatening to harm themselves or others
- Exhibiting explosive or dangerous behaviors
- In need of immediate mental health stabilization
- In need of immediate substance use evaluation
- Struggling with sadness or depression

Current Students:

CANCELLATION OF STATE ASSESSMENTS

Current Seniors:

If a senior is expected to graduate in spring 2020 and has not met the exit criteria for Algebra I EOC and/or Grade 10 ELA FSA, or earned a concordant score, this criteria will be waived.

However, students still must earn the necessary credits and meet the GPA requirements to graduate.
